Brace yourself for a no-holds-barred fundraising event on July 22, 2017 as we transform Gannett Road into a "no speed limit" zone for the ninth annual Sun Valley Road Rally brought to you by the Blaine County Drug Coalition.

## EXHIBIT 3

### DRIVER PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT LIABILITY RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

1. I am a driver or passenger participating for fun and recreation in the Sun Valley Road Rally which is organized by the Blaine County Community Drug Coalition, a nonprofit Idaho corporation (the Drug Coalition) All references to the Drug Coalition shall include its board of directors, officers, employees, volunteers, agents, automobile inspectors, Sun Valley Road Rally road crew, the County of Blaine and its employees or agents, and any other persons or entities assisting the Drug Coalition in the event . The event shall include the Sun Valley Road Rally and Car Show.
2. I acknowledge and agree that I have read and will abide by the rules and regulations of the Road Rally attached hereto. In addition, I will follow any other directions of the Drug Coalition and may be excused from participation in the road rally without refund if my behavior is deemed unsafe or disruptive by the Drug Coalition. I understand that I will be solely responsible for the safety and condition of my vehicle. I will ensure that all required safety components are installed and fit properly on the car. I understand that the items listed on the inspection form do not guarantee my safety or the safety of others. I release the Drug Coalition from any liability because of participating in the inspection or the results thereof.
3. I understand and willingly accept and assume all risks which are inherent in driving at high rates of speed on a road in Blaine County, Idaho or otherwise. These risks include, but are not limited to, loss or damage to personal property, injury or death to me or others due to the vehicle leaving the road, colliding with another vehicle, person, animal or other object or other incidents involving my vehicle. I acknowledge that these risks are impossible to eliminate with even the most prudent and careful planning on the part of the Drug Coalition and that participating in this event may entail unavoidable risk of life, personal injury and property and other damage.
4. I agree to accept sole responsibility for the safety of the passengers of my car.
5. I agree to be solely responsible for any medical treatment, ambulance costs, emergency evacuation or related costs arising from my participation in the event. I represent and affirm to the Drug Coalition that I have consulted with my medical doctor and been advised that I am medically fit to participate in the Road Rally.
6. I agree to maintain and provide evidence of a comprehensive policy of liability and collision insurance current at the time of the event in an amount satisfactory to the Drug Coalition, in the amount not less than one-million dollars, which cover s any damage to my auto and personal injuries to myself, passengers and others.
7. I agree to be solely responsible and pay for any damage to the roadway caused by me.



8. I hereby give my permission to the Drug Coalition and its agents to photograph me and/or film the event without charge or expectation of payment. This includes the right to disseminate photos of the event to the public.
9. I hereby release the Drug Coalition from all liability as to any losses, suits, claims, including expenses and attorney's fees, incurred because of any action, negligence, gross negligence or misconduct of the Drug Coalition. This release includes damage to my vehicle or equipment, injury or death to myself and anyone accompanying me to the event or passengers in my vehicle.
10. I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold the Drug Coalition harmless from all demands, actions, causes of action, suits or complaints, including attorney's fees, that may be brought by me or anyone on my behalf, or my heirs or any third parties as a direct or indirect result of my participation in the event.
11. In executing this document, I certify that I am of sound mind and voluntarily execute this document.

## **EXHIBIT 4**

### **DRIVER PARTICIPANT RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Each participant is given the opportunity to legally run his or her car over the speed limit for a short distance. Upon completing the Road Rally Inspection Form in full and submitting the form to the Sun Valley Road Rally Staff on or before July 1, 2017 and receiving confirmation of completed registration packet, drivers will be allowed to participate in the Road Rally. If your vehicle does not pass event inspection for any reason, you will be disqualified and not be refunded.

All paperwork must be completed in full and all safety requirements as listed on the Inspection Form must be followed. Please also note that Sun Valley Road Rally may disqualify entrants based on answers in the Medical Statistics form. If you are disqualified on this basis, you will be refunded our entrant fee.

You must fill out all registration forms, agreement and releases, inspection form and submit it with payment and photocopies of a valid driver's license, vehicle registration and auto insurance by July 1, 2017.

A photocopy of a valid driver's license, vehicle registration and auto insurance must be submitted with registration materials.

ALL drivers must be at least 21 years of age.

ALL drivers must wear a helmet.

## INITIAL EACH!

1. **SNELL RATED HELMET:** You must have current dates on the helmet - no exceptions.  
Helmet to be in good condition with accompanying eye protection. This is the minimum standard.
  - a. Shatterproof eyeglasses will be the minimum standard if helmet is not full face with eye protection.
  - b. If open cockpit, a full face helmet will be required.
  - c. A padded neck collar and/or a helmet restraint system are recommended.
  
2. **SEAT BELTS:** Correctly installed factory seat belts, OEM or better, is the minimum standard. Belts must be in "as new" condition and contain a shoulder and lap strap. Vintage cars must have newer seat belts or harnesses. Lap belts used without any shoulder restraints are not permitted.
  
3. **CLOTHING:** Non-synthetic fabric clothing (cotton, wool, leather etc.) to cover torso, arms (to biceps) and legs is required. Driving gloves are highly recommended. NO open toed shoes, shorts, tank tops or cowboy boots may be worn.
  
4. **ROLL BAR/CAGE:** A competition approved Roll Bar for an open vehicle (convertible) is mandatory unless your vehicle is equipped with a factory roll system. **ALL CARS THAT PLAN TO ATTEMPT A SPEED RUN OVER 181 MPH ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A FOUR POINT ROLL HOOP AS MINIMUM.** The material and minimums are as follows:  
  
**FOR DOM or ERW**
  - a. under 2000lbs:  
1.50"x.120"
  - b. 2001-3500lbs:  
1.75"x.120"
  - c. Over 3500lbs: 2.00"x.120" FOR Alloy (CM)
  - d. under 1500lbs:  
1.375"x.095"
  - e. 1501-2500lbs:  
1.625"x.095"
  - f. Over 2500lbs:  
2.000"x.095"
  
5. **TIRES:** Tires must be no more than four years old. If this is not shown on site, driver will be disqualified. All tires must be DOT approved "Z" "W" "Y" rated tires (or better) will be considered the minimum standard. DOT approved race tires are approved.
  - a. All tires must have an equal (or greater) Load Carrying Rating and Speed Rating than the original (OEM) manufacturer's requirement.

1. Driver registration and inspections will be at Silver Creek Ford on Friday, July 21,
  - a 2017 from 8:00 a.m. -4:00 p.m. **THIS IS MANDATORY** A safety/ logistical meeting will follow with lunch being served at noon.
2. A medical profile is required for all participants and must be submitted with registration forms prior to the rally. If the Sun Valley Road Rally event staff feels you are unable to participate due to medical issues, they are authorized to make that decision. If this happens, you will be refunded your entire entrant fee.
3. Road Rally Inspection forms must be completed and submitted no later than Friday, July 21,
  - a. 2017. Please also bring a copy of your Inspection Sheet with you.
4. 4. Please be prepared to identify your fuel type at the event inspection if you are using anything other than pump gas. The Crash Rescue Team **MUST** be aware of any vehicle that has NOS, nitro, methanol, acetone, or any other oxidizers, additives or exotics aboard. Only commercial gasoline's of commercially available octane's are permissible. No fuel truck will be provided.
5. All drivers must be 21 years of age to participate.
6. All drivers are required to wear a Sun Valley Road Rally lanyard around their neck after signing in. You only get one lanyard and you will not be permitted to participate unless you have it on at the starting line.
7. All crew and spectators registered on driver registration sheet are required to wear a Sun Valley
8. Road Rally wristband.
9. Car storage for participant vehicles can be arranged at the Silver Creek Ford the evening prior to the Rally. If you are interested, please contact the Silver Creek Ford to arrange for the overnight storage, (208) 578-5466, or other needs, well in advance.
10. Foot Traffic on the rally way is permitted by driver participants, their approved crew and guests and the Sun Valley Road Rally staff only.
11. Children under the age of 18 must be with an adult at all times. Children are not allowed to operate any type of motorized vehicle at any time.
12. Participants and spectators are not allowed to bring pets.
13. No glass bottles are allowed.
14. Please be respectful of your surroundings - the event is taking place in Blaine County and on private land. Please pick-up after yourself. If you damage the grounds in any way, including an on-track incident or other damage to the roadway, corridor, flora and/or fauna, you will be held liable for the damage.
15. **No alcohol** is permitted during or before the rally.

16. No barbeque pits, cigarettes or flames permitted onsite.
17. Please remember to stay hydrated. Drink plenty of non-alcoholic and non-carbonated fluids.
18. Blaine County Sheriff's Department and Officers will be serving as Sun Valley Road Rally security during the event.
19. There will be a sheriff patrol car in your sight as you accelerate off to the right side of the course. If this officer displays his patrol lights, **THIS IS THE SIGNAL THAT THERE IS A PROBLEM ON THE COURSE OR WITH YOUR CAR AND YOU ARE TO ABORT YOUR RUN AND REDUCE SPEED AND SLOWLY APPROACH THE PATROL VEHICLE!**
20. There will be a required safety luncheon from 12:00 p.m. - 1:00 p.m. at the Benny's Rod Shop on Friday, July 22, 2017 for all drivers.
21. Driver pictures will be taken with Sheriff Steve Harkins during the safety luncheon on Friday.
22. This will be the only time pictures will be available.
23. During the event, no one is allowed past the boundary cones that line the span of the rally track unless they are TOW/PUSH CREW for a participant. Spectators must remain in the roped spectator zone and are unauthorized to leave unless accompanied by Sun Valley Road Rally event staff.
24. From the start line to the timing traps, please focus and concentrate. If you have any problem during your run, gently steer the car to the right to get off the racing track and gently roll out of the throttle while braking to a safe stop. You may have fluids on your tires so steer and brake carefully to avoid spinning. If you put fluids down on the racing line, the clean-up time will delay your competitors. Come to a safe stop off the racing track. **Get off your i&mition.** Our crew will come get you. For safety reasons, your crew is not allowed to come get you on the rally track. The spectator area will be on the left, thus the emergency exit is to the right of the highway.
25. In case of an incident/accident on course, the family, friends, and crew of the participant should remain at the spectator area until law enforcement arrives to escort you to an appropriate location. Family, friends, and crew are not allowed to get on the course or pass through the cones.
26. If you are on course and you are dropping fluid please move to the left/right side of the track/cones.
27. In the case of a weather cancellation the day of the event, some veteran drivers have expressed a desire to donate all the funds to the charity; that being the ultimate purpose of the event.

As this is ultimately an act of God, the Blaine County Community Drug Coalition has no control over weather. We will make every effort to delay the rally, give drivers every opportunity to participate on Saturday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Finally, the event has grown in scale to where it is no longer possible to offer a Sunday rally as an alternative for weather delays.
